

About the Adempas Aim Support Program

Your healthcare provider has prescribed Adempas for you. The Aim Patient Support Program can help you during your treatment journey with Adempas. Participation in the Aim Patient Support Program is optional. Learn about its elements below.

HOW THE AIM PATIENT SUPPORT PROGRAM CAN HELP YOU:

1. Your Adempas Aim Access Coordinator will:

- Call you to review your prescription insurance coverage for Adempas
- Provide information on the different aspects of the Adempas Aim Patient Support Program, including nursing services, financial support, and educational materials
- Mail you an Adempas Welcome Kit with brochures and a pill box (your Adempas medication will be shipped separately)
- *[For female patients only]* ensure you are enrolled in the Adempas REMS program and understand the requirements

Note: It's important that you answer/return calls from the Aim Patient Support Program. The Caller ID is "AIM Support" or "855-423-3672."

2. A Specialty Pharmacy Representative will:

- Coordinate your shipment of Adempas to your home (Adempas is not available through your local pharmacy)
- Call you to discuss Adempas, including dosing and use with other medications, and schedule a conversation about nursing support.
- Call you each month to:
 - Arrange each Adempas shipment
 - *[For female patients who can get pregnant]*, confirm a monthly pregnancy test has been completed due to the risk that Adempas can cause serious birth defects if taken during pregnancy

Note: It is important that you answer and return calls from the Specialty Pharmacies. Specialty pharmacy calls may come from telephone numbers you do not recognize. If you miss a call from a specialty pharmacy about Adempas, be sure to call back to ensure timely processing and shipping of your medication.

3. A Specialty Pharmacy Nurse will:

- Provide information on Adempas
- Complete a periodic check-in
- Review your status
- Be available 24/7 to answer questions about Adempas

Note: It is important that you answer and return calls from the specialty pharmacy nurse. These calls may come from telephone numbers you do not recognize. If you miss a call from a specialty pharmacy nurse about Adempas, be sure to call back.
